

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Little Easton) (30MPH & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 201\*

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Section 84(1) and (2) and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

### Effect of the order:

1. To amend the 30MPH speed limit order on Duck Street, Little Easton in the District of Uttlesford by replacing the existing descriptions with the following (this will ensure the legal order matches the current signing on site, no physical changes will be made on site):

Road	Description
Duck Street, Little Easton	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. From a point approximately 63 metres west of the public footpath No.26, Little Easton north-westwards to a point approximately 10 metres northwest of the northern boundary of property known as Ripley.</li><li>ii. From the projected north western kerb line of Park Road westwards for a distance of approximately 38.5 metres.</li></ol>

2. To introduce a 40MPH speed limit on the following Duck Street, Little Easton in the District of Uttlesford (the road is currently national speed limit):

Road	Description
Duck Street, Little Easton	From a point approximately 63 metres west of the centre of public footpath No.26, Little Easton south-eastwards to a point approximately 38.5 metres north west of the projected north western kerb line of Park Road (Measured along the northern kerb line of Duck Street).

'The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Restricted Road) Order 2006' is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to lengths of roads in Little Easton only. All other restrictions will remain in force.
