## MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLYHELD ON WEDNESDAY 25<sup>TH</sup> APRIL AT 7.30PM IN THE MEMORIAL HALL

- 1. Apologies for absence were received from Janina Jones and Cllr L Smith (UDC). There were no declarations of interest for items on the agenda.
- 2. The Chairman welcomed guests and gave her annual report. A report was also received from the County Councillor.
- 3. Minutes of last Annual Parish Assembly were agreed as a true record and signed by the Chairman.
- 4. **Gravel Pit**: David Hunter, SRC Aggregates Ltd, gave a presentation and answered questions on the new gravel pit.
- 5. **Five Parishes Village Games:** Jackie Marling gave an update on the events for adults and children to take place between 27<sup>th</sup> July and 12<sup>th</sup> August. T-shirts will be printed and medals will be given out. J Marling agreed to keep the Clerk informed of the cost. Children will compete at the Jubilee sports for a place in the finals at the primary school on 28<sup>th</sup> July. Information on adult events can be found at the pubs.
- 6. **UDC New Homes Bonus Jubilee Fund** for parish councils and community groups was outlined by the Clerk and support was shown for a Parish Council bid to refurbish the Memorial garden area by re-painting the railings, repairing the gate, adding fencing and a bench. A group in the village would be interested in bidding for funds for an item of play equipment. This idea was also generally supported by members of the public.
- 7. **Public forum** and questions from residents: R Boulton was notified that a stretch of footpath P22 was inaccessible. Thanks were given to Parish Councillors for all their hard work throughout the year.
- 8. **Queen's Diamond Jubilee Celebrations:** A working party has been set up to arrange the street party and a grant of £250 was received by the Parish Council for the event.

- 9. **Speeding/traffic calming in the village:** Traffic calming measures have been requested by the Parish Council and a response is awaited from ECC.
- 10. Litter picking: A group of residents would be interested in litter-picking and asked if a rota might be formed, with equipment loaned from the District Council.
