  the same might be used in perpetuity as an open space under the Open

- (3) The Council have laid out supported maintained and improved the greater part of the said land as and for the purpose of a playing field but have recently erected upon a small portion thereof shown on the plan of the said land hereto annexed a building for use as a parish hall and have requested the Estate Owner to release and vary the covenants contained in the hereinbefore recited Conveyance which he has agreed to do—

  NOU THIS DEED WITHESSETH that in consideration of the premises the Estate Owner in exercise of the nover for this purpose conferred on him by statute and of any and every other power in him hereunto enabling hereby As Trustee as respects claims by or on behalf



of the owners from time to time of the said land at Little Easton formerly vested in the Donor but not further or otherwise releases so much of the said land comprised in the before-mentioned Conveyence dated the 27th day of May 1930 as now constitutes the site and curtilage of the said parish hell from the before recited covenants contained in the said Conveyance and from the right of reverter therein contained to the intent that the Council may hereafter hold the said parish hell and be entitled to use the same as such free from the said Covenants and right of reverter PROVIDED

ALVAYS that as respects the remainder of the said land comprised in the said Conveyance the said covenants shell remain in full force and effect and that as respects the whole of the said land the said Conveyance and the provisions thereof shall remain in full force and effect save as hereby expressly varied—


